LADOT Transit completed its Moving Forward Together project that included a detailed Transit Service Analysis of all routes and programs within the LADOT Transit network. LADOT Transit presented initial recommendations online, in publications, at meetings and public hearings. Based on the comments received LADOT Transit formulated final recommendations. The Los Angeles City Council approved the implementation of these specific service changes for DASH, Commuter Express, Cityride, and the launch of LAnow an on demand shared-ride service

On Demand Shared-Ride

LAnow is a new on demand shared-ride service, designed by you. Hail a ride through the LAnow smartphone app, online, or by phone. Within the service area, pick-up/drop-off spots are never more than a few blocks (1/4 mile) away. You can also meet us at the LAnow Rideshare Hub at the Palms Expo Station.

DASH Downtown

- Service until 9pm weekdays.
- Weekend service on all routes.

DASH in your Neighborhood

- Weekend service on all routes.
- Earlier weekday service.



Service to New Areas

- Route 437B – New route added express trips morning and evening to Playa Vista.
- Route 439 – New route is a reverse of Route 438 and will serve Downtown LA to/from El Segundo.



New to Cityride

- Ride FREE on DASH services.
- Online registration.

Increased Subsidies

Quarterly fare value increases to \$84 and taxi subsidy increases to \$20 per ride.

More Dial-A-Ride

- More Cityride Dial-A-Ride trips available for all your trip needs.
- Maximum cost of \$4 for Dial-A-Ride trips.
